



WHITE WINES

SAUVIGNON BLANC

Ara 'Pathway Sauvignon Blanc- Marlborough

Glass \$6.50 / Bottle \$31.00

Pathway (English translation for the word ARA). This Marlborough wine is from- an ancient river terrace formed through unrelenting geological processes. Retaining the classic expression of the region with full flavours, lively citrus and tropical fruit aromas, delivered with a clean refreshing finish

Carrick 2008 Sauvignon Blanc- Central Otago

Glass \$7.50 / Bottle \$36.00

A vibrant fresh nose displaying classic Sauvignon Blanc, characters of red peppers and passion fruit with tropical notes. The subtle acidity gives this wine a delicious focus and direction.

Richmond Plains 2008 Sauvignon Blanc- Nelson

Bottle \$34.00

Richmond Plains produced New Zealand's first certified organic Sauvignon Blanc.

A lively, lightly creamy front of lemon, clover and gooseberry flavours, followed by a fleshy, full bodied, flavoursome mid section with a good acid balance. The long finish maintains the bright character of the wine nicely.

Forrest Estate 2008 Sauvignon Blanc- Marlborough

Glass \$8.50 / Bottle \$39.00

The lifted aromas of this wine offer lemon, thyme, black currant, elder flower, a hint of passion fruit and a mineral aspect reminiscent of wet stones. A New Zealand Classic from Wairau valleys famous river bed.

Cloudy Bay 2007 Sauvignon Blanc- Marlborough

Bottle \$52.00

Mouth-watering aromas of passion fruit and lemongrass led with the spiciness of just-picked tomatoes tossed with fresh basil. Many small parcels of fruit, ripened under ideal conditions, bring layers of complexity to the Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc. The palate has exceptional richness, with ripe gooseberry flavours and a hint of fresh fennel leading to a powerful, crisp finish.

CHARDONNAY

MOMO 2007 Chardonnay- Marlborough

Glass \$7.00 / Bottle \$35.00

This light Golden coloured wines, brings along the aromas of ripe stone fruit, tropical fruit and citrus. The palate shows good concentration of fruit with a creamy texture, balanced by a refreshing acidity

Carrick 2008 Unravalled Chardonnay- Central Otago

Glass \$8.00 / Bottle \$38.00

The 2008 Unravalled Chardonnay is a subtle mix of stone fruit, nectarine and white peach aromas, with hints of sweet ground almonds and toasted oak. The complex flavours on the palate are complimented by a full bodied structure.

Chard Farm 2007 Closeburn Chardonnay- Central Otago

Bottle \$43.00

A fruity aroma of nectarines, peaches and cream with complex earthy notes. Soft and round fruit flavours in the mouth with a nutty, leesy complexity and an elegantly balanced finish.

AROMATICS - Pinot Gris, Riesling and Gewurztraminer

Shaky Bridge 2008 Pioneer series Pinot Gris-Central Otago

Glass \$7.50 / Bottle \$35.00

The intoxicating aromas of flowers, melon, spices and orchard fruits invite you to a full and perfectly balanced mouthful of wine. The myriad of aromatic flavours continues on the palate, joined by lemon zest in a clean, crisp complete finish.

Clutha Ridge 2008 Pinot Gris-Central Otago

Glass \$7.00 / Bottle \$34.00

This fresh and dry Pinot Gris displays aromas of pear and nectarine. The palate combines stone fruit freshness and the minerality of the Clutha, with a refreshing and bright finish.

Shaky Bridge 2008 Riesling-Central Otago

Glass \$8.00 / Bottle \$37.00

Creating a wonderfully fresh and zesty wine full of lemon, lime and Alexandra minerality. These characters are balanced with low to moderate acidity, making a crisp wine with a beautifully clean finish and offering a complete Riesling experience for lovers of this variety

Muddy Water 2008 'Lough Vineyard' Riesling-Waipara

Bottle \$41.00

Intense, medium-dry Riesling with strong apple and lime flavours. Subtle sweetness is perfectly balanced by fine juicy acidity. The finish lasts for ever and an ethereal texture finishes the picture.

Matua Judd Estate 2007 Gewurztraminer- Gisborne

Bottle \$47.00

Delicious green colour, the nose has classic examples of Gewurztraminer combining aromas of rose petals, Turkish delight and spice. The palate is generous and fruity with a solid structure that lingers.



SPARKLING WINES

Bubbles for Brigid 2005

Bottle \$41.00

A classic New Zealand Method traditional sparkling with Lemon/straw-hued in colour, it erupts in the glass with tiny bubbles and inviting, fresh-scented, biscuity yeast aromas. It's lively on the palate, smooth, creamy and rich yet delicate with fresh acidity and a lasting finish.

Matua Valley Sparkling

Bottle \$34.00

Opens with aromas of glazed pineapple, subtle muscatel and crisp green apples. Light in colour, freshness greets the nose, followed by a full palate of refreshing "bubbly" sensation. A wine to be savoured and enjoyed



RED WINES

PINOT NOIR

Shaky Bridge 2005 'Pioneer series' Pinot Noir- Central Otago

Glass \$8.00 / Bottle \$39.00

Rich, Earthy, savoury aromas are brightened by sweet red fruits and warm spiciness. Cherries and berries mingle in the palate with rounded tannins and well balanced acids, giving a supple mouth feel to the wine.

Carrick 2008 'Unravalled Pinot Noir- Central Otago

Glass \$9.00 / Bottle \$43.00

This wine displays lots of vibrant fruit from red cherry, raspberry to blackberries with a hint of spice underneath. The front palate is packed with sweet bright fruit with the same red cherries and blackberries on the nose following through to the flavours. The soft tannins give this wine lovely mid-palate weight with a dark cocoa finish.

Chard Farm 2007 'River Run' Pinot Noir- Central Otago

Bottle \$48.00

Dark ruby red. Intense aromas of dark red berry fruits and red currants give way to complex violet and subtle spice notes The wine has ripe berry fruit flavours, excellent weight and texture in the mouth and the fine persistent tannins lead to a long and elegant finish.

Main Divide 2008 Pinot Noir- Waipara

Bottle \$46.00

There are aromas and flavours of cherries and red berry fruits with impressions of raspberries, mulberries and blackberries. There are also savoury hints of grilled mushrooms, black olives and roast game. Ripe fine grained tannins give it structure and length, but these are covered with a velvety robe, leaving impressions of dark chocolate and spice.

SHIRAZ

PepperJack 2005 Shiraz-Barossa Valley

Glass \$7.50 / Bottle \$34.00

The 2005 Pepperjack Shiraz is rich red in colour with soft purple hues. The nose shows aromas of blackberries and plums, supported by characteristic pepper and spice. The palate is rich, round and soft with concentrated berry fruit and hints of anise. 15 months barrel maturation in seasoned and new American and French oak has enhanced the complexity, velvety tannins and length of flavour.

Wolfblass 2005 'Gold Label' Shiraz-Barossa Valley

Bottle \$39.00

Plentiful, ripe, forward fruit here, with a sooty, charcoaly edge on the nose. Full, sweet, fruit berry crumble. Not too overdone. There is some fruit freshness on the palate which is attractive, but also a little note of confection and a herby depth which adds deep interest.

Penfold 2006 Bin 28 Kalimna- Barossa Valley

Bottle \$54.00

A ripe, slightly spiritry but typically generous Barossa shiraz, this meaty and slightly reductive young red has a liqueur-like aroma of black and red berries, plums and dried herbs overlying sweet cedar/ chocolate/vanilla oak. Plush and juicy, it's soft, supple and approachable, with a moderately rich palate of concentrated fruit and creamy oak framed by fine, loose-weave tannins

MERLOTS, CABERNETS AND BLENDS

Temata Woodthorpe 2007 Merlot Cabernet- Hawkes Bay

Glass \$7.00 / Bottle \$34.00

Te Mata Estate Woodthorpe Merlot/Cabernet '06 is a deep magenta colour, with aromas and flavours of dark cherry, blackcurrant, cinnamon and vanilla. A fine, even tannin structure carries right across the palate to a sustained finish.

Forrest Estate 2005 Merlot- Marlborough

Glass \$8.00 / Bottle \$38.00

Meaty and rich, a fabulous nose that just begs for a spicy curry. Smoke, grilled meat, red plum sauce, a touch of sweet dried thyme. The fruit comes through on the palate – all red fruits, lots of juicy red plums, along with redcurrants and red crab apple jelly – yet the finish is fine and dry. Be warned – this wine will make you hungry.

Main Divide 2006 Merlot Cabernet- Waipara

Bottle \$39.00

It has a bright ruby hue. The merlot has a given, sweet raspberry and purple plum fruit flavours while the cabernet sauvignon and cabernet franc have added cassis and spice. In the mouth it initially appears plump and soft but underneath there is a backbone of taut muscley tannins which draw out its length and add a savoury dry finish
